WINEMAKER: Michael Schreurs

VINTAGE: Warm spring providing ideal flowering and subsequent fruit / canopy development. An early vintage with bright natural acidity and even ripening.

ALCOHOL: 13.5 %

TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.19 grams/litre

pH: 3.54

COLOUR: Vibrant ruby red

BOUQUET: Complex bouquet, Morello cherry, rhubarb, charcuterie and dry herbs with hints of forest floor.

PALATE: Approachable and soft; Satsuma plum, sarsaparilla and bresola, with fine, savoury tannins.

ALTITUDE: 500m above sea level

ASPECT: South East facing site in a cooler and wetter region of the hills, just out of Woodside.

CLONES: MV6, 114, 115, 777

SOIL: Free-draining clay and loam with strong water holding capacity.

Conceived in France and created in the Adelaide Hills, The Lane wines are neither European nor Australian in style, rather the best of both worlds. These wines have the structure and finesse of Europe's best, complimented by intense fine fruit flavours and spice, a product of Australian sunlight and the terroir of The Lane.
